Entries sent to any other address will not be accepted. **Make checks payable to TRBA.** Please mark entry as Open or Youth. Rabbits and Cavies must be on separate entry forms. **All entry forms must be signed.** **Any entry not marked open or youth will be entered in the open show.** **NEW ARBA RULE:** Youth exhibitors may enter sanctioned youth shows between the ages of five and 18 years of age. An adult cannot show in youth classes at any time. Youth exhibitors must be able to handle their own animals. If stated in the show catalog, all youth entries must be carried by youth. Youth exhibitors are not required to carry their own animals to the table. Entry forms are available on TRBA web site: texasrba.net, or from TRBA Secretary 254-986-2331, txrbasec@mcecw.net

SALE COOPS - A limited number of Rabbit/Cavy Sale Coops will be available at the cost of \$8.00 per coop, one (1) rabbit/cavy per coop. If you wish to rent Sale Coops you must include the number of coops on your entry along with the proper fee. No sick or baby rabbits/cavies will be allowed.

ANIMAL ARRIVAL DEADLINE - VERY IMPORTANT: This is an early entry cooped show. All rabbit and cavy exhibitors must check in with the appropriate show secretary prior to 9:00 pm on Friday, March 26th. If you do not check in with the appropriate secretary by 9:00 pm your entry will be scratched and entry fee will be forfeited. **No Exceptions.**

ENTRY FEES: Open Rabbit, Youth Rabbit, Open Cavy, Single Fryer - \$7.00 per animal. Meat Pens - \$7.00 per pen, Fur \$3.00 per animal (animal must be entered in class to compete in fur), Substitution Fee - \$1.00 per animal. Entry fees must accompany signed entry, **postmarked no later than February 22, 2010.**

ENTRY FORMS: **ONLY TRBA ENTRY FORMS WILL BE ACCEPTED.** Multiple rabbit breeds may be included on the same entry form. Rabbit & Cavy entries must be on different entry forms. Be sure to mark entry as open or youth. **Entries not marked as open or youth will be entered in the open show.** **Entry fee must be included with the entry and entry must be signed.** If fees are not included, and entry is not signed, entry will be returned to exhibitor. You must use the TRBA entry form available on our web site at: texasrba.net, or contact TRBA Secretary for entry forms to be mailed to you.

VERY IMPORTANT - If you have made an entry and will not be able to attend, IT WILL BE GREATLY APPRECIATED if you will call the appropriate secretary at the number above.

ANIMAL RELEASE – EXHIBITOR PACKETS – CONTEST MATERIALS: No animals will be released prior to Open Best In Show on Sunday. All exhibitor packets and contest materials must be picked up after Open Best in Show on Sunday. None will be mailed.

NEW UPDATED ARBA SHOW RULE – SECTION 52: Youth exhibitors may enter sanctioned youth shows between the ages of five (5) and eighteen (18) years. An adult cannot show in youth classes at any time. Youth exhibitors must be able to handle their own animals. If stated in the show catalog, all youth entries must be carried by youth. Youth exhibitors are not required to carry their own animals to the table.

GENERAL SHOW RULES

1. This is an official ARBA & TRBA Sanctioned Show and will be governed by the latest show rules.
2. Entries must be postmarked by February 22nd, and mailed to TRBA - 8761 Aycock Road - Moody, TX 76557. This includes rabbits, cavies, booth rentals and early banquet tickets. This is a cooped show and no late animal entries will be accepted. Deadlines will be strictly enforced
3. **Completed Youth Royalty contest application with copy and 1 - 4 x 6 or smaller photo must be postmarked by February 22 and mailed to: Karen Morgan, 7869 FM 3117, Temple, TX 76501. Individual youth contestants must sign up for contests by 9:00 p.m. on Friday, of the show.**
4. All animals must be in the showroom no later than 9:00 p.m., Friday. **No Exceptions.** Exhibitor must check in with appropriate secretary. No animals will be allowed to enter the showroom on Saturday. Animals may not be removed from showroom until completion of Open Best-In-Show on Sunday.
5. Exhibitors must pick up all comments cards, legs, Youth Contest testing materials, etc. upon completion of Open Best-In-Show. None will be mailed. No animals will be released prior to open BIS.

6. Only TRBA Entry Forms will be accepted and must be signed by exhibitor or parent/guardian. TRBA Entry Forms are available on the TRBA Web Site texasrba.net or request entry forms from TRBA Secretary to be mailed to you. If all information is not included you will receive a collect call. PLEASE INCLUDE MULTIPLE BREEDS ON THE SAME ENTRY FORM. Rabbit and Cavy entries must be on separate entry forms. Send **original signed entry**, no copies.
7. Substitutions (\$1.00 each) will be allowed in the same breed, variety, class and sex only and must be completed by 9:00 p.m. Friday night.
8. Exhibitors must provide feed and water containers for each animal entered. If containers are not supplied, exhibitor will be required to remove those animals from the building and will forfeit entry fee. Exhibitors are responsible for feeding and watering their own animals.
9. All rabbits/cavies must be owned by the exhibitor a minimum of thirty (30) days prior to exhibition.
10. Only youth (5 through 18) will be allowed to enter/carry youth show animals to and from the judging tables.
11. Any animal owned by an adult or an adult with a youth May not be entered in the youth show.
12. All rabbits must be clearly and permanently earmarked in the left ear. All cavies must be earmarked by a tattoo or ear tag in the left ear. This rule will be strictly enforced. Judges will be reminded to disqualify animals with illegible tattoos.
13. Ear number and weight will be verified on the top 5 animals in each class.
14. No animals may be entered in both the Open and Youth (age 5 through 18) show.
15. Any rabbit/cavy showing signs of sickness or disease will be removed from the showroom and will not be judged. Entry fee will be forfeited.
16. No breeding of animals will be allowed in the showroom.
17. NO COOLERS, COFFEE POTS, FOOD, ETC. WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE BUILDING. IF YOU BRING ANY OF THESE TYPES OF ITEMS INTO THE BUILDING, YOU WILL BE SUBJECT TO DISCIPLINARY ACTION AS DETERMINED BY THE SHOW COMMITTEE AND TRBA BOARD.
18. The Show Committee reserves the right to make any changes necessary, including substitution, addition or deletion of any judge.
19. No animals other than rabbits, cavies and CERTIFIED seeing eye dogs will be allowed in the show building.
20. Judges decisions will be final. No harassing of any judge will be allowed.
21. Exhibitors will not be allowed to sell rabbits/cavies unless they are entered in the show. No baby rabbits/cavies will be allowed on the show grounds or allowed to be sold. The only animals which will be allowed in the show room are those entered in the show, donated to the Scholarship/Equipment Raffle or those for which a sale coop has been rented.
22. No rabbits/cavies may be kept in carriers under coops. All animals must be in their assigned coop.
23. Only TRBA & rented booths will be allowed to set-up in the building. Sale of any type merchandise or any other items will not be allowed unless booth space has been approved and rented.
24. Any exhibitor removing animals prior to official checkout will forfeit all points, payback, awards, etc. and will not be allowed to show in future TRBA shows and may be subject to further disciplinary action by the TRBA Executive Board.
25. The TRBA and Bell County Expo will not be responsible for any loss or damage.
26. TRBA will provide good quality hay for bedding. If you use an excessive amount of bedding or want shavings, please provide your own.
27. The TRBA is not responsible for any breed specials.
28. If you place cardboard, ribbons, wires, ties, etc. on, in, or between your cage and another, it is your responsibility to remove it prior to tear-down.
29. Absolutely no chairs, grooming tables etc. allowed in the aisles. The Fire Department has asked that we do a better job of keeping all aisles clear. This includes between and around the cooping.
30. A limited number of Sale Coops will be available at \$8.00 per cage, one animal per cage. You must include the number of sale coops on your entry form along with the proper fee. No sick or baby rabbits/cavies allowed.
30. TRBA is not renting the arena this year and not allowed in that section of the building. Therefore, Clubs must schedule meeting time and meeting area with Chairman Don Mersiovsky, lepus@hot.rr.
31. If you have made an entry and will not be able to attend, call the appropriate secretary so they may correct the records and run the paperwork. Open 817-312-0305, Youth & Cavy 832-260-2398.

DUTIES OF BREED CHAIRMEN: The individual specialty breed clubs are responsible for selecting the breed chairman for their breed and for seeing to all aspects of the judging of the breed. The club president must notify Tony Bell, Asst. General Superintendent, 817-790-8106, e-mail tbell637@yahoo.com, with the name of the appointed breed chairman. If there is no affiliated breed club, the show committee will designate a breed chairman. The president of the specialty club is responsible for seeing that the chosen breed chairman completes the following: (1) Attends the Breed Chairmen meeting Saturday at 7:00 a.m. (2) See which exhibitors in your breed have not checked in with the Show Secretary and verify they have not placed their animals in the coop/s. (3) Verify that all rabbits entered in your breed have the coop number in the right ear. This helps locate the proper cage if an animal gets out and coop numbers are used in judging. (4) Private ear number and weight to be verified on top 5 animals in a class (5) Secure at least 2 table writers to take comments and control sheets for your breed. (6) Have another person call classes for the judge. (7) Have designated carriers to carry rabbits to and from the judging table. (8) When judging of your breed is complete, see that all placings and specials are marked and that the breed folder gets to the Show Secretary as soon as possible. Best In Show cannot go on the table until all folders have been returned to the Secretary's office. (9) See that exhibitors have fed and watered their animals during the show. (10) If you secure specials money for your breed, post a list where your exhibitors will see it and pay it out immediately upon completion of judging. It is your responsibility to see that specials are paid. (11) See to it that all exhibitors remove their animals as soon as possible after Open Best In Show has been announced and that all ribbons, cardboard, cage ties, etc. are removed from the coops. (12) If you are a breed chairman and are unable to attend the show, you must contact your breed club president so he/she can make sure someone is there to take your place. If no designated breed chairman has been named by the Specialty Club, the Club President will be responsible for these duties.

BANQUET/DANCE TICKETS: To purchase Banquet Tickets at the discounted rate, the form must be postmarked no later than **February 22nd**, at the price of \$18.00 per adult and \$12.00 per youth (under 13 years of age, ages will be verified). An order form is in this catalog. Late tickets may be purchased after the deadline at the rate of \$23.00 per adult and 15.00 per youth (under 13), at the TRBA Secretary's Booth until 11:00 a.m. Sat, if any are available. PURCHASE EARLY.

SHOW AWARDS: Must be current TRBA member to receive these awards, otherwise, specialty club rules will apply for sanctioned breeds. **OPEN & YOUTH RABBIT SHOW:** BEST IN SHOW, 1ST & 2ND. RUNNER UP, BEST & BEST OPPOSITE OF BREED for all sanctioned breeds, 1st. & 2nd, PLACE MEAT PENS, 1st. & 2nd. PLACE. SINGLE FRYERS. **OPEN CAVY SHOW:** BEST IN SHOW & 1st. RUNNER-UP. **YOUTH RABBIT SHOW RIBBONS:** Thanks to Petrus Feed & Bunnyrabbit.com for donating 1st.thru 5th.place ribbons for our youth rabbit show.

WAYS & MEANS RAFFLE: All raffle items are donated by our members, clubs and friends. Many really nice items will be in the Raffle. ARTS & CRAFTS CONTEST: We will have Open and Youth entries and each will have three categories, Photography, Arts and Crafts. EACH ITEM MUST BE THE ORIGINAL WORK OF THE EXHIBITOR AND MUST HAVE BEEN MADE SINCE APRIL 1, 2009. Items do not have to be rabbit related. Photography will consist of color or black and white pictures. Arts will include drawings, paintings, printmaking, computer generated pictures. Crafts will include: woodworking, ceramic, jewelry, sculpture, needlework, wearable art, stamping/stencil/folk art, etc. The youth will be broken down into 3 age divisions: 9 & under, 10-13 and 14-18. There will be trophies for 1st. and 2nd. in each category for each age group. The entry fee is \$5 each with no limit to the number of entries per exhibitor. The items must be entered at the Ways and Means raffle table either on Friday night or by 9:00 a.m. Saturday. Judging will be at 11:00 am Saturday. The winners will be announced and awards presented during the TRBA banquet Saturday night. Entries may be picked up after 9:00

TRBA YOUTH CONTESTS AND ROYALTY COMPETITION – YOU MUST PARTICIPATE IN THE TRBA JUDGING AND/OR BREED IDENTIFICATION CONTESTS TO BE ELIGIBLE TO REPRESENT TRBA AT THE 2010 ARBA CONVENTION. Karen Morgan is Youth Contest Chairperson, Adult Advisors are: Pam Heaton, Renee Lovorn, Jessica Morgan, Bob Sorrels, Mike Withrow, Beth Lawrence. **VOLUNTEERS ARE NEEDED. IF YOU CAN HELP, PLEASE CONTACT KAREN MORGAN AT 254-983-0007, MorganJKKL@msn.com.** **Royalty and Individual Contest Age Divisions** - Participant age is determined by the age of the individual on the closing day of the annual TRBA State Show: 15-18 years - King/Queen Division; 12-14 years - Duke/Duchess Division; 9-11 years - Prince/Princess Division; 8 years and under- Lord/Lady Division. You must be a current TRBA member to enter and must live in the State of Texas. Royalty Applications are required and may be found on the TRBA website or by request from the Karen Morgan, MorganJKKL@msn.com. All Royalty Contest entries must be postmarked by February 22, 2010. Any entries postmarked after this date will be disqualified. Entries must be mailed to Karen Morgan, 7869 FM 3117, Temple, TX 76501. Royalty Contest winners will be determined by a composite score from the Written Test, Hands-On Judging Contest (Showmanship for Lord/Lady contestants) and Breed Identification. TRBA youth members who do not enter the Royalty Contests may sign up for the individual contests before 9:00 p.m. on Friday night, Breed Identification Contest, Hands-On Judging Contest (Showmanship for ages 8 and under) and the Written Test. Hands-On Judging will consist of placing two classes of four animals each with a time limit of 7 minutes per class. The Standard of Perfection may be used. Breed Identification will consist of approximately 20 animals (rabbits and cavies) to identify by breed, showroom classification, 4 or 6 class, and registration variety. Written tests will draw upon information from the ARBA Official Guidebook to Raising Better Rabbits and Cavies, the ARBA Yearbook, ARBA Standard of Perfection, the ARBA Domestic Rabbit Guide, current issues of the Domestic Rabbit magazine, the TRBA Yearbook, and current issues of the TRBA News. Team members of the Texas Judging or Breed Identification Teams for the 2010 ARBA Convention will consist of the highest scoring individuals in each contest, with two alternate names. Youth who will change age division before the ARBA Convention will need to judge in the next higher age category to be eligible for the state team. Contests will begin at 7:00 a.m. on Saturday morning. Contestants should be available until 3:00 p.m. to resolve any ties. Individual contest winners, Royalty Contest winners and state teams will be announced at the TRBA Banquet on Saturday evening. Trophies and awards not claimed at the banquet may be picked up at the Youth Secretary area after 9:30 a.m., Sunday. Unclaimed awards will not be mailed. Youth contest materials will be placed in the contestants' packet along with comment cards and show reports which may be picked up from the Youth Secretary at the conclusion of the show.
